Director's Report

Renovation Update

My council presentation on June 13 was received with interest regarding the nature of each phase and the approach of Phase One as essential library services for the first and second floors. So, the message that this is a capital improvement project for systems that are beyond their life cycle is getting through. They all wanted more information about how this project would be/ could be financed. At the June 27 Committee of the Whole, Julie Vaillancourt (City Finance Director) spoke about possible GO Bond funding for the project. Sadly, this was at 9 PM as it was a long and sometimes contentious meeting. There was really no time or interest in discussing further. I am left wondering how to "workshop" the project - phase one; what's included, who / how will it be funded.... with the council. I would like to invite the public to the library to "Talk about the future of the Vaughn" so there are more education opportunities for council members and their constituents. I am looking at Wed Aug 9, 6 pm and Thurs Aug 10, 6 pm to offer these sessions to our community. If any of you are available to attend, this would be a good way to express commitment to the project and discuss with people what is involved, how we got to where we are now, how it will impact them and maybe make changes, if there is overwhelming consensus in one direction.
