

Vaughn Public Library Board of Trustees meeting on March 11, 2026.

The meeting was called to order at 5:44 p.m. by Mary.

Motion/second by Lynn/Clarence to approve the agenda. CARRIED.

Motion/second by Jim/Peter to approve the February 11, 2026 minutes. CARRIED.

There was no public comment.

Building project: Sarah reviewed the progress to date. The book moving company has been here, having brought the teen and juvenile collections over. Shelf space has been refigured to accommodate the new layout. The final inspection of the building has not been done. There are a number of things that need attention before we accept the building as finished.

Guests: April Stone told of being an artist-in-residence at local schools. She has had a studio in the old section of the Beaser school, which is closing. She explained her connection to the community and talked about artist space in the city. Sheva asked about the basement of the Vaughn building as an artist space. Sarah said the condition of the basement is without windows and not really suited for human habitation.

Sarah reviewed the circulation/activity report and the financial report.
